Future

Time has come to expand; we are currently busting at the seams and need more housing. State regulations will not allow us to increase occupancy until our septic system is upgraded to allow for the increase in capacity. Therefore plans are in motion to install a septic system that will allow for any future expansion (total estimated cost \$30,000.00).

Construction of the new RV sites was started last year and put on hold by the State until the septic system is upgraded (total estimated cost \$10,000.00).

As with most things, upgrades and additions to facilities cost money. As a result we have launched a major fundraising campaign to help with our short and long term financial needs and to insure the future success of WKYC for many years to come.

As most of you already know, camp fees are intended to pay for just the day to day operations leaving nothing for upgrades, emergencies, or additions. For these things we rely on donations from individuals, businesses, and area church congregations. In the past WKYC has been very blessed to have had such wonderful supporters.
